- Select one of the activities below to complete this term. All contributions will be used at our World at War Exhibition at the end of March.
- Homework is due on Tuesday 24th March 2020

Research the conditions in WWI trenches. Write up your research and bring it in with a 3D trench model (see an example below):



Research the blitz. What was it? Where and when did it happen? Why did it happen? Who was affected? Create a ‘blitz’ picture like the one below and write up your research to go with it.



Find out what a Victoria Cross is. Research some of the people who received this and why they were given it. Create a 3D model of one and bring it in with some of the stories written up for the exhibition.



Interview someone who was alive during WW2. Create an audio or video recording or a written transcript of the interview. Submit this to your teacher for visitors to listen to or read at our exhibition.



Speak to someone who was alive during WW2. Do they have a story to tell you? Write it up as a recount.
