**To help my child at school, I know and understand that:**

-  If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone
-  If my child, or any other child within their bubble, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school and we will self-isolate for 14 days or until a negative test result is confirmed.
-  On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules
-  Only one adult will drop off and pick up my child and ensure the allocated times are adhered to
-  My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school – apart from a named lunch box (if needed) and a named water bottle
-  I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully
-  My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene
-  I will not be allowed into the school without a pre- arranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email
-  I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an ‘as safe as possible’ environment during this crisis
-  Read all messages/emails that are sent home
-  I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to our emergency contacts details
-  If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

**As a pupil, I will do my best to:**

-  Stick to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground
-  Tell an adult if I feel unwell
-  Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school – apart from my lunch box and a water bottle
-  Only use the equipment provided to me by school
-  Not mix with any children in other bubbles
-  Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it)
-  Wash my hands for 20 seconds, frequently and whenever asked by an adult
-  Behave well at all times to keep myself and others safe
-  Follow these expectations and know that if I don't I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe
