What your child needs to do if you need to self-isolate.

If you and your family need to self-isolate, then please make sure you contact the school office to let us know.

Make sure your child keeps up to date with their learning!

Our class pages on our school website should have everything you need. Each week, teachers update their class web pages with a blog all about the week ahead. On there you will find all the different learning activities set by your class teacher. The activities will be relevant and similar to the learning that is taking place in your child's classroom. They will post links to lessons on the Government's National Oak Academy website and BBC schools, where qualified teachers will talk through the learning in the format of videos, quizzes, and activities. Teachers will also be updating Education City and Bug Club regularly so please make sure you have your login details kept safe to use if needed. (Please note that Bug Club is for KS1 and Reception children only).

If you don't have internet access, then please contact your child's teacher who will organise paper resources to be sent to your home address.

We ask that you keep in touch with your child's teacher regularly during the time you are isolating and send in pictures of the work that your child is completing. Teachers will then provide feedback where appropriate.

Please support and encourage your children to complete their work and contact your child's teacher if you need any further help, support or guidance.
