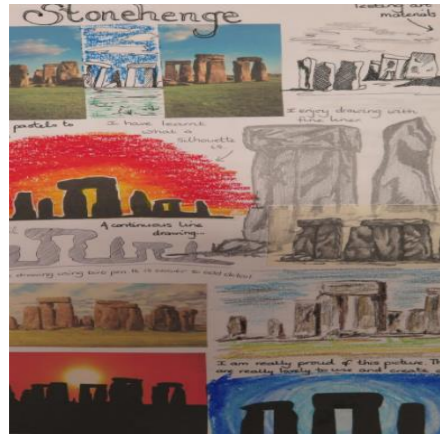


Year 3/4 Homework Grid – Autumn 2nd Half of Term

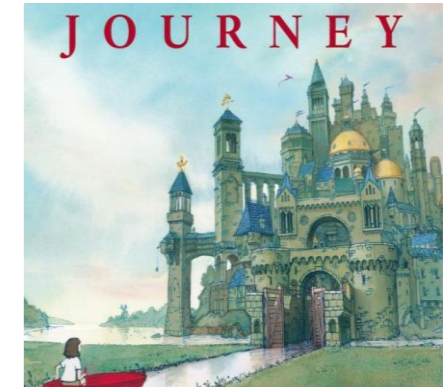
Balloon Voices Investigation

You will need: Balloon
Scissors
Cardboard tube

- Gently place one finger on the balloon, and talk down the cardboard tube. Can you feel what is happening?

Design a postcard

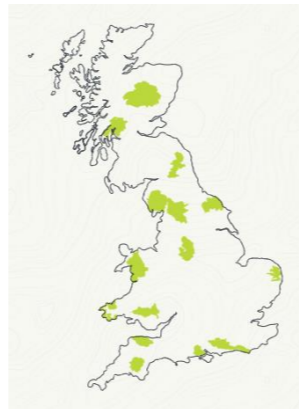
Pick a seaside holiday destination in the UK and design a postcard.
