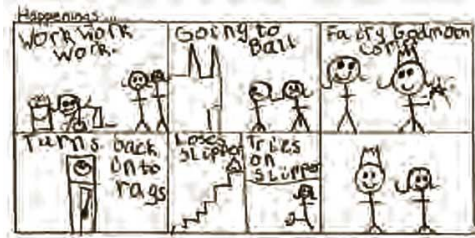


## Year 3/4 Homework Grid – Summer 2nd Half of Term

Paint a scene of Greek setting. They like their blues and whites!



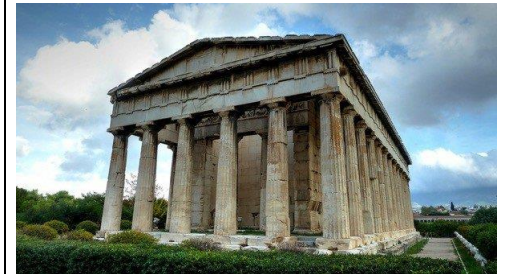
Can you write a persuasive letter to someone encouraging them to visit King's Lynn?
