

Part of the Norfolk Local Offer for learners with Special Educational Needs

At Greyfriars Academy we strive to support **all** children to enable them to achieve at school. In order to do this many steps are taken to support them through their learning journey.

At different times in their school career, a child or young person may have a special educational need.

At Greyfriars we identify a child's barriers to learning, and **plan support to help the child overcome** these barriers. Barriers may involve learning, relationships, language and communication or physical difficulties.

Special Educational Needs provision is **additional to or different from the** normal differentiated curriculum.

Parents or teachers may raise a concern about a child's limited progress, or a change in behaviour.

We follow the Assess, Plan, Do, Review cycle:

Children receiving SEN support or those with an EHCP have a Learning Journey. This shares the child's individual needs and target areas for development using the following system:

ASSESS

We use a range of assessment tools, including advice from outside professionals to determine a child's barriers to learning and decide on the best type of support to give.

PLAN

We set outcomes and review the child's progress towards these regularly.

DO

Additional support is given in the classroom, or through small group interventions.

REVIEW

We work with families to regularly review the child's progress towards set outcomes and agree new ones.

We follow this process on a termly basis, involving the child in decisions as much as possible.
